Introduction

Round 1 Funding Solicitation – Request for Response (RFR)
and Request for Ideas (RFI)

- Solicitation released December 21, 2005
- Materials available from Commonwealth's Procurement Access & Solicitation System (Comm-PASS)



Locating Documents

1. Comm-PASS website: **www.comm-pass.com**
2. Search for solicitation:
 - “RFR ENV 06 NRD 02”
 - “RFI ENV 06 NRD 01”
3. Select RFR or RFI from search result and select RFR or RFI solicitation and click “View”,
4. Select “Specifications” tab and select documents for viewing or download. For example:
 - “ENV 06 NRD 02 Instructions”
 - “RFR ENV 06 NRD 02”



Restoration Priority Categories

Restoration projects must address at least one of the following categories:

- **Aquatic Biological Resources and Habitat**
- **Wildlife Resources and Habitat**
- **Recreational Uses**
- **Environmental Education and Outreach**

Applicants will identify the Predominant Restoration Priority Category as well as any Secondary Restoration Priority Categories.

MA SubCouncil Goal: To implement at least one project per category in each funding round.



Evaluation Criteria

Category	# of criteria	Max. points
Relevance and Applicability	7	85
Technical Merit	6	65
Project Budget	6	60
Socioeconomic Merit	7	75
TOTAL	26	285

NOTE: Scoring for each criterion is a scale of High, Medium, or Low.
Scores for criteria are weighted (i.e., some criteria have more points than others).



Eligibility: Who, What, Where?

Eligible applicants:

All private entities; local, state, federal and tribal governments; academic institutions; non-profit and commercial organizations.

Eligible projects:

Any project that would directly benefit injured natural resources and/or services in the Housatonic River watershed in Massachusetts.

Eligible project locations:

Projects may be conducted at any location, but they must directly benefit the injured natural resources and/or services in the Massachusetts portion of the Housatonic River watershed.

- June: Review Team Concludes Evaluation of Applications
- July: Public Meeting – Results of Evaluation
Public Comments Due on Applications
- Aug: MA SubCouncil Determines Preferred Alternatives
- Oct: Release of DRAFT Restoration Plan (30-day review period)
- Nov: Public Meeting – DRAFT Restoration Plan
- Dec: Release of FINAL Restoration Plan
- Dec: Beginning of Funding Disbursement for Restoration Projects
